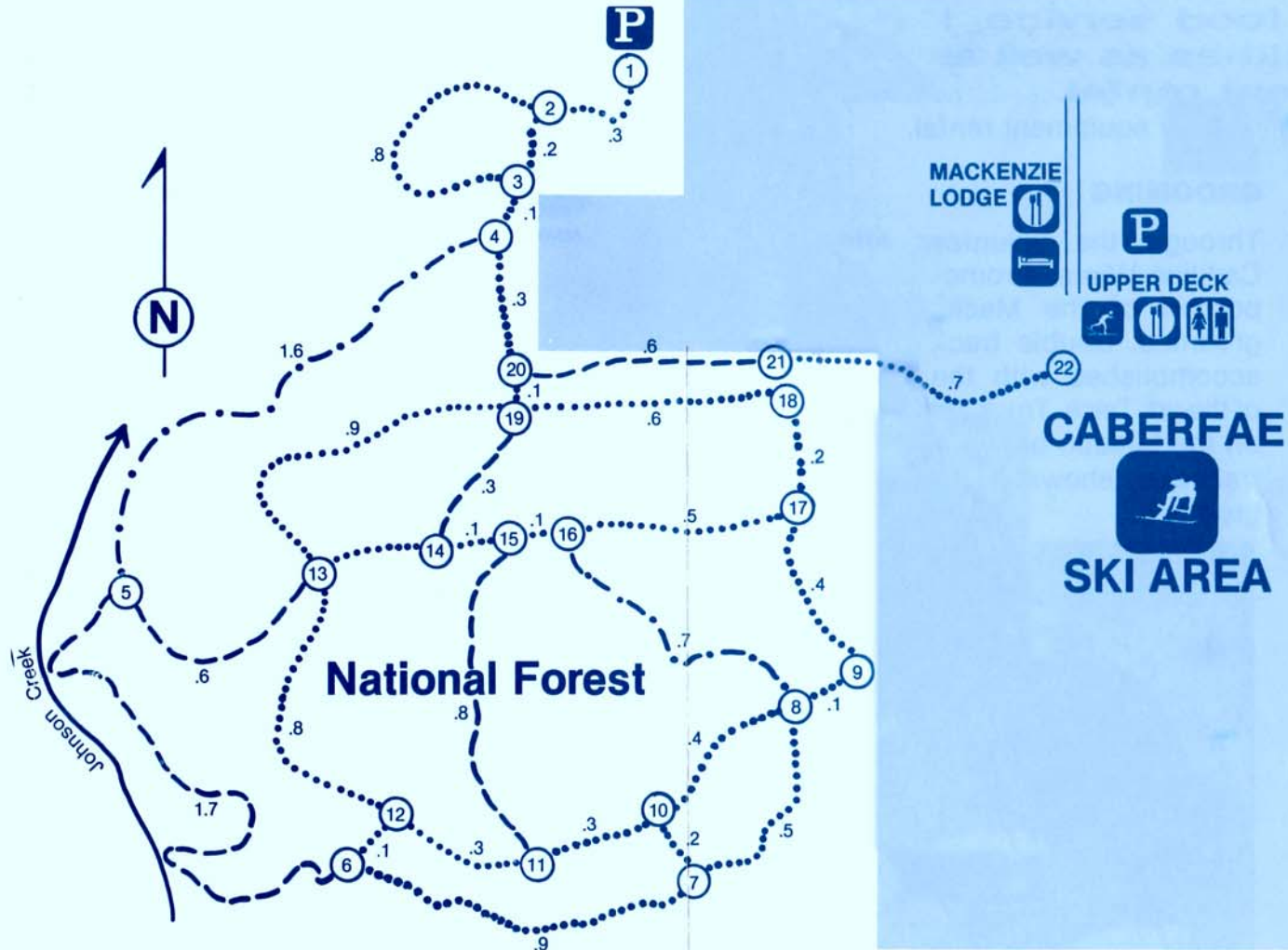
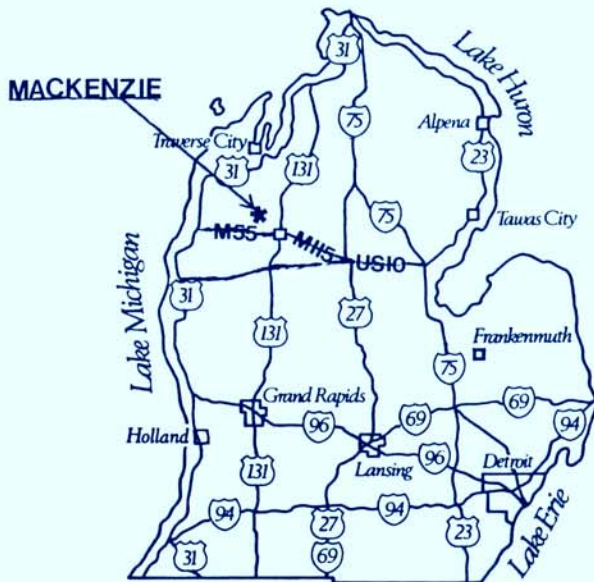


The Mackenzie Cross-Country Ski Trail is an outstanding nordic trail set in a beautiful northern hardwood forest adjacent to Caberfae Ski Resort near Cadillac. The trail is jointly located on Manistee National Forest and Caberfae land.

The trail system totals 15 kilometers (10 miles) with loop combinations of varying lengths available for all levels of cross-country enthusiasts from novice to advanced. The trails are marked with blue diamonds. Trail location maps, skiing difficulty levels and directional signs are posted at each intersection.

LOCATION

Take M-55 west of Cadillac 12 miles to Caberfae Road, then north 2 miles. Trail entrances are located on 38 Rd. 1 mile west of Caberfae or at the base of Caberfae's Instructor Hill.
