



HELPFUL HINTS FOR WEEKLY SCHOOL LEADERS 2020-2021

The Group Sales office is located on the side of our Ticket & Rental Sales building.

All group ticket, rental, lessons and meal transactions take place at the Group Sales office. For a speedy check-in for you and other group leaders checking-in behind you, please have the following ready:

1. The total number of lift tickets needed. Caberfae Peaks will calculate the complimentary tickets.
2. Total number of rentals sorted out by ski and board. Tell us any deletions/additions if you are using our Express Rental Reservation Program.
3. Number of lessons needed sorted by ski or snowboard.
4. Have payment ready.
5. Register your cell phone number (or a member in your group) in case of an emergency.
6. Bring a list of all members in your group each time you come in case of an emergency. We will provide our ski patrol team with this list after registration.
7. Please bring with you the signed rental & liability release agreements for each student participating in the night school program whether they are renting or not.

GENERAL GROUP & SCHOOL INFORMATION

- The cost for our Night School Skiing Program is only \$8. Ski rental is \$2, snowboard rental is \$8, helmets are complimentary for our regular after school groups. All other weekly groups pay a discounted \$3 per helmet fee. The program is offered after school hours Wednesday – Friday and comes with complimentary beginner group lessons for students 6 years of age or older.
- The group leader (one member) will be responsible for the transaction and the distribution of all lift tickets and additional products. The group leader will provide the Group Sales office with one form of payment upon arrival. Cash, check or credit card. We do not accept multiple payments for discounted tickets or products.
- One complimentary lift ticket will be provided for every 10 purchased tickets with our school programs. This means that your 11th, 22nd, 33rd, 44th, 55th, etc. lift ticket is free of charge. Parents and faculty are encouraged to join the students at the discounted student rate.
- School reservations for lift tickets, rentals, and lessons should be made at the beginning of the season. Please let the Group Sales office know your starting date, along with your arrival time and approximate number of students each week.
- Only one member of your group should check-in at the Group Sales office. Please have your group wait on the bus or in a designated area. Do not have your group go to rental until after check-in.
- **Any changes to ticket orders must be made by the group leader no later than 1 hour after arrival. No refunds will be given after that time.**

RENTAL EQUIPMENT INFORMATION

Our Express Rental Reservation Program can greatly reduce the amount of time your students spend in the Rental Department. There are two options to process rentals.

Option 1 - Recommended for Groups Coming on a Regular Basis

1. Caberfae will compile a database of all students & their measurements from the Rental & Liability Release Agreements or we can come to your school to measure your students, in which we will also provide info and demonstration for the upcoming Night School Skiing Program.
2. The Group Leader will then only have to email or fax over a list of students coming 48 hours in advance.

Option 2 - Recommended for Groups with 3 or Fewer Trips

1. Our Express Rental Reservation Forms are created using an Excel document that can be downloaded from any group page on our website, or we can share it as a Google Doc by email request. By submitting the Rental Reservation Forms in advance (at least 48 hours prior to arrival) our Rental Department will have your students equipment set and ready to go. New additions on the night of arrival may still rent, however their equipment will not be preset.

- No minimum is necessary for school discounts on rental equipment packages or ski/snowboard lessons.
- Caberfae Peaks will need to receive the Express Rental Forms no later than 48 hours before your arrival time in order to process your forms. Forms submitted later than this cannot be guaranteed processing.
- Students wanting to upgrade from skis to a snowboard after arrival will need to pay the additional \$8 at the Group Sales Office.
- Be sure to review the Skier Type Chart page to determine which category of skier matches your student's style when filling out the rental forms.
- The group leader is responsible for making sure all rental equipment is returned to our Rental Department before departure.

SCHOOL LESSONS

Our ski and snowboard instructors are eager to teach people how to ski or snowboard. Our beginner group lessons are highly recommended for any participant 6 years of age or older. Each week our instructors will provide your students with lessons in skiing or snowboarding. These lessons will offer students the basics of stopping, turning, becoming familiar with equipment and learning to ride the chairlift.

School lessons go out on the 1/2 hour. The last lesson is scheduled at 5:30pm, except on Fridays when the last lesson is scheduled for 6:30pm. You must let the Caberfae staff know in advance approximately how many lessons you need prior to arrival otherwise instructor availability will not be guaranteed.

HELPFUL PLANNING TIPS

- Remind everyone in your school of your departure time and set meeting times and places for everyone to check in during the evening. The chairlifts run until 8pm Wednesday & Thursday and 10pm Fridays. (Friday nights until 10pm in the months of January & February, 9pm in the months of December and March.)
- Return all group forms and rental information in a timely manner so that we can be prepared when you arrive. Each student's parent must sign the rental and liability release form in order to participate in the program.
- Encourage lessons! Keep track of lessons by category: ski or snowboard.
- Plan ahead and stay organized. Most problems arise when groups aren't prepared.

Rental and Liability Release Agreement

Parent or Guardian, PLEASE READ CAREFULLY before signing

I agree upon behalf of the minor user I am representing to accept for use AS IS all equipment to be provided during the multi-week program and agree to accept full responsibility for the care of the equipment while it is in the users possession. I will be responsible for the replacement at full retail value, as listed in the Ski Rental Shop, of any equipment provided under this form, but not returned to the shop, for any reason whatsoever, included but not limited to equipment, which is lost, stolen or misplaced. I agree all rental equipment will be returned by the agreed date.

I agree to reimburse the Caberfae Management Corporation, and its Ski Rental Shop for any loss or damage of any kind to the rental equipment other than reasonable wear and tear from the use of the equipment.

I agree that either I, or an authorized designee, will execute the verification on the front of this form for each session. All user information I provide will be true and correct.

I understand that the binding system cannot guarantee the user's safety. In downhill skiing, the binding system will not release at all times or under all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which it will release. In snowboarding and cross-country skiing, the binding system will not ordinarily release during use: these bindings are not designed to release as a result of forces generated during ordinary operation.

I understand that the sports of skiing, snowboarding, snowblading and recreational activities involve inherent and other risks of **INJURY** and **DEATH**. **I voluntarily agree to expressly assume all risks of injury or death** that may result from skiing/snowboarding/snowblading/helmet use, participation in this multi-week program, or which relate in any way to the use of the equipment to be issued to the user.

I agree to release the ski/snowboard shop, its owners, affiliates, agents, officers, directors and the manufacturers and distributors of the equipment (collectively "PROVIDERS") from all liability for injury, death, property loss and damage which results from the equipment user's participation in the sport of skiing/snowboarding, participation in the multi-week program, or is in any way related to the use of the equipment, including all liability that results from the NEGLIGENCE of PROVIDERS, or any other person or cause.

I further agree to defend and indemnify PROVIDERS for any loss of damage, including any that results from claims or lawsuits for personal injury, death, and property loss and damage related in any way to the use of the equipment or participation in the multi-week program.

This agreement is governed by the applicable law of this state. If any provisions of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other provisions shall be given full force and effect.

I, THE UNDERSIGNED, HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS EQUIPMENT AND LIABILITY RELEASE AGREEMENT. I AFFIRM THAT I HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO THIS AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE MINOR USER I AM REPRESENTING AND AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT.

CLASSIFY YOURSELF

Determining your skier type is your responsibility!

So what type of skier are you? There are three classes of skier types: Type I, Type II and Type III. Consult the descriptions below to select your classification. Your skier type, height, weight, gender, age and boot sole length are used by our ski shop technicians to determine the visual indicator settings of your ski bindings. Be sure to provide accurate and complete information as any error may increase your risk of injury or any uncompleted information will result in your equipment not being set.



SKIER TYPE I

- Ski conservatively
- Prefers slower speeds
- Prefers easy, moderate slopes
- Favors lower than average visual indicator settings. This corresponds to an increased risk of inadvertent binding release in order to increase the likelihood of release in a fall.
- Type I settings apply to entry level skiers uncertain of their classification.



SKIER TYPE II

- Ski moderately
- Prefers a variety of speeds
- Prefers varied terrain
- Type II skiers are skiers who do not meet all the descriptions of Type I or Type III skier types.



SKIER TYPE III

- Ski Aggressively
- Prefers fast speeds
- Prefers steeper & more challenging terrain
- Receive higher than average visual indicator settings. This may reduce the likelihood of release in a fall in order to decrease the risk of inadvertent binding release.

What does it mean, “Green” - “Blue” - “Black”?

Green circles are the color and symbol used for the beginner easiest trails to ski or board on. This is where all beginners ski or ride.

Blue squares are the color and symbol used for more difficult trails, or for intermediate skiers and riders.

Black diamonds and double diamonds are the trail color and symbol used for the most difficult and extremely difficult trails.
